## CREATING THE QS YOUTH CENTER

### WHY THIS SPACE MATTERS

Across the country, 2SLGBTQIA+ youth face immense challenges. A staggering 85% of 2SLGBTQIA+ youth experience harassment at school, and The Trevor Project estimates that more than 1.8 million 2SLGBTQIA+ youth ages 13-24 seriously consider suicide each year in the U.S. - and at least one attempts suicide every 45 seconds.

Through affirming hangouts and hands-on workshops, 2SLGBTQIA+ youth build confidence, community, and pride – all while exploring new skills. In collaboration with community partners and volunteers, QUEERSPACE hangouts uses a group mentoring model where Queer youth regularly connect with Queer adults and staff in safe, welcoming spaces. Because we know, it takes a collective to raise a generation of thriving 2SLGBTQIA+ youth.



### **CONNECTING QUEER YOUTH IN ST. CLOUD**

In an area where affirming spaces and resources can be scarce Youth QueerConnect has become a steady after-school anchor for 2SLGBTQIA+ youth in the St. Cloud area.

In partnership with St. Cloud Pride and Great River Regional Library, these monthly drop-in hangouts offer a welcoming space for Queer teens to show up as their full selves, make friends, and build community through group activities like crafting, board games, and more.



### FORGING NEW PATHS AND TOOLS WITH IAMA



In partnership with Industrial Arts Mentorship for All, youth in our blacksmithing workshop completed an 8-week course on the fundamentals of blacksmithing, learning traditional techniques from seasoned artisans. These hands-on sessions sparked endless creativity as they transformed raw iron into hooks, bowls, artwork, and even a hiking stick.

#### SPINNING BEATS WITH DJ BLOWTORCH

The coolest collab to drop: we teamed up with local legend Shannon Blowtorch - a DJ with nearly 30 years in the live music scene - to host a 6-week DJ workshop in the Twin Cities.

Youth learned the craft and business of DJing, from reading a crowd to discovering their own style and sound. The grand finale? A community dance party where participants took to the stage and spun an electrifying playlist that was 100% them.

### MENTOR/MENTEE MATCHES





QUEERSPACE collective was founded on a simple but radical belief: we all have the right to show up as our authentic selves. While there are more than 5,000 mentorship programs across the U.S., less than ten are specifically dedicated to 2SLGBTQIA+ youth. In 2021, QUEERSPACE launched one of the first of its kind - a mentorship program created by and for Queer youth.

Luca and Kate were one of our very first mentorship matches. When they met three years ago, Luca was still exploring his gender identity and went by a different name. Kate became one of the first people he trusted enough to say aloud that he believed he was Transgender.

He worried about telling his parents, concerned it would burden or upset them. But it was in part due to Kate's steady presence and support that, as an eighth grader, Luca found the courage to come out to his family.

Now older, Luca says he loves being part of QUEERSPACE, a place where he can exist

without judgment. Having someone like Kate, who's not a parent, teacher, therapist, or peer, has been life-changing. It's a relationship rooted in mutual trust and affirmation.



We're able to have a lot of fun and joke around, but also have deep conversations, he said. Having advice from someone who's lived longer than me is really important. After our hangouts, I've thought, 'Yeah, that's helpful. I'm going to use that.'




